

Rev James Carroll, P.P., Kilfinane

The death of the Rev James Carroll, P.P., Kilfinane, was announced on Saturday last, after an illness lasting several months. A kindly, zealous clergyman in the sacred mission, he was born at Kiffin some 63 years ago. Educated at Maynooth, he ministered at Bruff and Limerick where he became Administrator prior to his pastorate at Kilfinane, where he succeeded the late Rev John Lee, P.P. A physically fine type of Soggarth, his health became seriously affected some two years back. He was beloved by all the city and county. Deceased was brother to Mr Thomas Carroll, many years chairman of Kilmallock Board of Guardians. St Michael's Temperance Society, of which deceased had been at one time President, was represented at the interment on Monday by Mr Jos O'Halloran and Mr B Gleeson, when the remains were interred after Requiem High Mass.
