Young Railway Porter Killed

On Tuesday evening Patrick Hogan, 16, railway porter, was killed at Ardagh station.

Engaged in shunting operations, while unhooking a goods train to Limerick, he was caught between the buffers and received terrible injuries to his head.

Dr McGrath, M.O., Ardagh, gave medical evidence.
