

Popular Citizen's Death

The Late Mr. John Reidy

The death took place on Saturday last in St John's Hospital of Mr John Reidy, proprietor of the Curraghgour Bar, North Strand after a very brief illness. The deceased, who was in his 60th year, had a seizure at 11 o'clock on Friday night, and was removed to hospital, where he passed away at 5 o'clock on Saturday morning. In early life deceased was a most popular member of the Limerick Typographical Society as a capable compositor. Later Mr Reidy, who was of a very pleasant and sociable disposition, took a keen and active interest in the public affairs of his native city as a member of the Limerick Borough Council and the Limerick Poor Law Board. Requiem Mass for the repose of his soul was sung at 10.30 a.m. on Monday, and the funeral, an exceedingly large and representative cortege, took place to Mount St. Lawrence Cemetery, amidst every manifestation of respectful sympathy.
