

Sudden Death in Limerick

A carter named Christopher O'Sullivan, while working at the Docks, had a sudden seizure on Monday morning and died within a few minutes. He was attended by a clergyman and removed to Barrington's Hospital, where he was pronounced dead. He was aged about 36, was unmarried, and had lived in Market Alley. A verdict of death from natural causes was returned by the jury under Mr J B McNeice, City Coroner.
