

Gored To Death

Bull Attacks County Limerick Farmer Fatally

Dr O'Leary, Coroner for East Limerick, held an inquest on Monday at Lemonfield into the circumstances of the death of Mr Garret Nagle, 70, a farmer who was gored to death on Saturday evening by a bull on his farm near the city.

Mr Nagle had gone armed with a pitchfork to attend the animal, who sprang at him, knocked him down and gored him, inflicting terrible injuries. When found Mr Nagle was dead.

Verdict—Death due to shock, caused by injuries from the cause described.

The late Mr Nagle was in old days a popular member of the Limerick No. 1 District Council, and was held in the greatest respect by a very wide circle of friends.
