## Young Citizen's Death

The death occurred at Barrington's Hospital on Sunday of Mr E Pearson, secretary to Messrs Goodwin and Co., china warchouse, Limerick. He had been handicapper and starter at the Church Lads' Brigade Sports on the 11th instant, when a small pistol he was using got jummed and discharged into his right hand. The injury was not at first considered serious, but later he had to be conveyed to Barrington's Hospital, tetanus supervening. Aged [41, he was third son of Mr David Pearson, Cooga House, Doon.

## Fatal Change of Mind

George Crockett Johnson, Wicklow st., Dublin, who had changed his original intention of travelling to Limerick by rail and decided to go by motor, was killed instantly in a collision near Ballybrittas, Leix. At Killinure cross-roads the car collided with a long owned by Mesars Dooley's, Birr, and driven by Mr B Coughlan.

It is now stated Mr Johnson was an uncle
of the late Mr l'estron, who died from the
effects of a tatal accident at the Church
Lade' Brigade sports, and was on his way
to the funeral at Limerick when the collision occurred.
