A shocking road accident attended by lated consequences occurred at Coffey's Bridge, Adare, on Tuesday evening, when John Greaney, labourer, aged about 70, was knocked down by a motor car and received terrible injuries to which he succumbed later at the Co. Hospital, Croom

THE INQUEST.

At an inquest at Drebetarana the jury returned a verdict that death was due to fracture of the skull. The coroner said the accident was unavoidable, and no blame could be attached to the driver of the car. Deceased was a native of Trebedtarans, Adam.
