# Death of Croom Nationalist Abroad

The death has taken place at Misericordia Hospital, New York, of Mr Thomas J Cummins, a retired plumbing contractor, of 125 Ninety-Second Street, New York. Death followed on being struck by an automobile. He was a native of Croom, Co Limerick, and emigrated to America in 1867. He was a prominent Irish Nationalist all his life, an energetic and whole-souled Catholic, having being a member of several religious societies, member of the Knights of St Columbus, and organiser of the Irish American Athletic Club. Nine of his children survive him, his son, Richard Cummins, being chief clerk and head of the Law Division of the Surrogate Court of New York.
