## Late Rev Father Cornelius Carroll, P.P.

Office and Requiem High Mass took place at St Michael's Parish Church, for the repose of the soul of the Rev Father Cornelius Carroll, P.P., East Hartree, Bristol, whose death took place on Sunday at Kilkee, where he had been on holiday. Deceased was aged 61 years, and was ordained at the Cathedral, Waterford, in 1867, his Ministerial career being subsequently spent in England. Owing to ill-health, he had resigned the Pastorship of East Hartree some time ago, and had resided at home. He was son of the late Mr M. Carroll, Master of Croom Union, and brother of Rev M. Carroll, Limerick diocese.

Rev Canon O'Leary, P.P., St Patrick's, presided at the requiem ceremonies. The Rev W. Carroll, C.C., St Michael's, was celebrant at the Mass; Rev Fr. Moriarty, C.C., deacon; Rev Father Kelly, C.C., sub-deacon, and Rev Father Brassill, C.C., St John's, master of ceremonies.

The interment was at Mt. St Lawrence. The chief mourners were:—Mr E. Carroll, Croom, brother; Mrs J. V. McDonnell, Kildorrery, sister.
