

Limerickman's Death In Brisbane

Death has removed at Brisbane, Australia, Dr. Matthew McNamara, where he had been at practice at his profession since he left his native land in the long won years gone by. Dr. Matt was brother of Mr. Thomas McNamara, Clondrinagh, Limerick, and of the late Mr. John McNamara, Snelbourne, and, like them, he was in his time devoted to athletics. He was of broad, generous ideas, and in his exile's home under the Southern Cross had made hosts of practical and sincere friends, who had held him in the highest esteem for his professional ability and gentlemanly attributes. He had been in falling health for some time prior to his demise, but had ever proved a willing friend and patron of his fellow-countrymen whom he met with from time to time abroad, and many of whom brought back home many tales of his unbounded friendship and kindness to them. Deceased was sister of Mrs. O'Donovan, Shannon Hotel, Castleconnell, and uncle of Mr. D. G. O'Donovan, Castleconnell.
