

Clergyman Killed at Nenagh

Motor Car Collides With Wall

Rev Michael Fanning, P P, Kilcoleman, Birr, was fatally injured when the motor car which he was driving struck a wall at Hogan's Pass, River Bridge, three miles from Nenagh, about 7 o'clock on Tuesday evening.

The tragedy has cast a deep gloom over the Diocese of Killaloe, in which deceased was widely known and greatly respected.

Father Fanning was accompanied by Miss Mulroy, Friar's street, Nenagh, his house-keeper, who escaped injury. He was removed to a house close by the scene of the accident where he died at 11 o'clock.

Deceased was a native of Clonakenny, Roscrea. He had been curate at Toomevarra before going to Kilcoleman. He was brother to Mr T Fanning, of Honey-mount, Dankerrin, Roscrea.
