Struck by Motor Lorry

A four year old child named Christopher McNamara was struck by a motor lorry at Nicholas street, near the Castle Barracks, on Thursday, and was fatally injured.

The body was removed to Barrington's

Hospital pending an inquest.

He received shocking injuries, a wheel of the lorry passing over his head.

At the District Court,

Patrick Byrnes, Ballinscourty, Castleconcell, was charged with the manslaughter of the child.

Sergeant Donnelly, Mary street, deposed to arresting accused. He made certain statements which witness would not hand in that day. He applied for a remand for a fortnight.

The remand was granted.
