

Killed By Motor Car

Charge Alleged Against Driver

At Limerick District Court,

Patrick Byrne, Ballinacourty, Castleconnell, was returned for trial on bail charged with causing the death of Christopher McNamara, 4 years, knocked down by a motor lorry in Church street, Limerick, on November 8th.

Mr P J Power, State Solicitor, prosecuted; Mr P E Collins, sol., defended.

Dr J Morris, Barrington's Hospital, said the child sustained fracture of the skull base and of the lower jaw.

The Justice said although there was not a strong case against defendant, he thought there was a case of investigation by a jury.
