

Death of Mr H. Kearney

The death of Mr Hugh Kearney, a popular Limerick man, who died at his residence, Duo Laoghair, on Tuesday, after a brief illness, is recorded. Deceased was for a period a good many years ago an official in the General Post Office, Limerick, and afterwards had a position with Messrs Shaw & Sons, later taking out an auctioneer's licence in his native city. He was a keen and capable business man, and enjoyed the confidence and respect of all classes. He was a good sportsman, and in social life in general was held in the warmest regard. Much of his spare time was spent in yachting, and in earlier life he was a great cyclist. He was married to the eldest daughter of the late James Hodgkinson, church decorator, Limerick.
