

Sudden Death of Limerick Engine Driver

Collapses at Dromkeen Station

When the goods train from Limerick to Waterford this morning arrived at Dromkeen Station, G.S.R., the driver, Michael Lysaght, aged 40, married man, took unexpectedly ill. He was on the footplate at the time, and was removed to the signal cabin, where he died some minutes afterwards.

Deceased lived in St Lelia street, Limerick, and leaves a young and large family, with whom the greatest sympathy is felt.
