Sad Tragedy

Man Drowned at Killaloe

A tragic accident occurred at Killaloe during the storm on Tuesday evening when Martin Costelloe, a workman in the employment of Miss Lefroy, Ballina, was drowned in the canal. He was cycling along the canal bank between the two streams to bring home Miss Lefroy's cows, and was apparently blown into the canal. The body was found a short time afterwards by the Gardaí near the spot where five Killaloe children were drowned some years ago. He leaves a wife and three children.

At an inquest held by Dr Scantlan, Tuilla, a verdict of accidental drowning was returned, and sympathy was tendered to the widow and children of deceased.

The Coroner recommended that the authorities should erect notice boards at the entrance to the canal in order to prevent further fatal accidents.
