

City Child's Sad Death

Died From Bonfire Burns

Kathleen Cullen, Watergate, aged 9½ years, died from burns at Barrington's Hospital on Monday.

With other children she had kindled a fire in the street of sticks, paper and other debris, and while blowing it alight her clothes caught fire. She rushed in home shouting to her sister, "Oh, Mary I am burning."

At the inquest the House Surgeon, Dr S McDonagh, said death was due to shock from extensive burns.

Deputy Coroner J S McNeice, sol, held the inquest.

Inspector Lyons, C G, who conducted the inquiry, said there were too many of these open fires in Limerick. Parents should not permit them, and the citizens should stamp them out when observed and notify the authorities.
