Charge of Murder of Brother-In-Law

Case at Adare Court

Charged with the murder of his brother-in-law, James Lyons, of Gulacloghane, on 1st July, Stephen Galvin, Gulacloghane, Lixnaw, county Kerry, appeared on remand before District Justice Kenny at a special court at Adare on Saturday.

Supt. Chambers, Listowel, informed the Justice that his inquiries into the case were not yet complete, and therefore he asked for a further remand to Listowel District Court on August 17th next.

The Justice formally granted the application to the date mentioned.

Galvin, who, at a previous court had appeared with his head heavily bandaged, was without his bandages, but appeared to take little interest in the proceedings.

The body of the deceased man was found in a field adjoining his own residence.
