Young County Limerickman's Death

The remains of Thomas Barlow, Ballylanders, aged 19 years, was buried at Mount Brass Cemetery, Galbally. He met his death when a horse which he was driving to the cemetery shied at a passing motor lorry; he was thrown on to the road, and one of the churns is believed to have fallen on his head, inflicting severe injuries to which he succumbed in Croom Hospital.

Some children in the car escaped.

The funeral was unusually large, due to the many relatives of the deceased, who were present from Croom, Kiltinan, Hospital, Galbally, Anglesboro and Ballylanders.
