DEATH OF THE VERY REV. CANON MURPHY.

Very Rev. Jeremiah Canon Murphy, P.P., V.F., Abbeyfeale, died at the Presbytery, Abbeyfeale, yesterday, in his 76th year.

Born in the parish of Dromcollogher, he studied at the Diocesan College, Limerick, and the Irish College, Paris, and was ordained in 1883, in St. John's Cathedral, Limerick. His first curacy was Tournafulla, and then spent nearly 20 years in Rathkeale.

He was appointed P.P. of Killeedy, where he revived the devotion to St. Ita, patroness of West Limerick. Later, he was appointed P.P. of Kilcolman, where he erected the new church, and left it free from debt.

In 1924 he was appointed P.P. of Abbeyfeale, appointed to the Chapter, and made a Vicar Forane.

Canon Murphy was a brother of Rev. T. Murphy, P.P., Croagh and of the late Rev. M. Murphy, P.P., St. Patrick's, Limerick.
