

# Death of Mrs. Julia M. Cashin

With the deepest regret we announce the death of Mrs Julia M. Cashin, wife of Mr Michael H. Cashin, of the "Limerick Chronicle," which took place unexpectedly at her residence, 16 Crescent Avenue, on Wednesday night last. The sad bereavement has caused the deepest sorrow to her beloved husband and relatives, and the most heartfelt sympathy is tendered to them in their sad affliction.
