

# Newport Murder Case

---

## Charge at District Court

At Limerick City District Court, before District Justice Flood, B.L.,

Sergeant Baggy applied for a week's remand in the case of Wm Reilly, a travelling tinker, in custody, on a charge of murdering John Dandon at Newport, on 17th January. Deceased was father-in-law of accused.

Mr Tyman, solr, for accused, said Reilly would admit striking the deceased.

The Justice—That will simplify matters. These two men were members of one tribe, and the death of Dandon was the result of a row. All the evidence required is to show was the blow the cause of death.

The accused was remanded in custody.
