President De Valera's Son Killed.

Widespread Sympathy

Whilst riding with his cousin, Dr Flanagan in the Phoenix Park on Sunday, Mr Brian De Valera, third son of President De Valera was struck by a branch of a tree and knocked off his horse.

He was unconscious when picked up a few minutes later. He was removed to the Mater Hospital where he died a few hours. His father and his brother Eamonn were present at the bedside.

World-wide sympathy has been extended to the President and Mrs De Valera in their bereavement.

Brian, who was 20 years of age, was one of a family of five sons and two daughters. He was in his second year of engineering studies at University College, Dublin, and was a very brilliant student.

The funeral took place this morning to Glasnevin Cemetery, and seldom has the Metropolis seen such a vast assemblage march through its streets.
