Sad Fatality at Galbally

Michael Donoghue, aged 72, was found dead in a deep snowdrift on his farm at Corderry, Galbally. He was unmarried and lived with his married brother. During the snowstorm on Monday evening he went to his own farm half a mile distant to look after his stock. There is a house on the farm and when he failed to return that night his brother thought he remained during the night at the house. Next day his brother sent his young son to the house for him but he was not there. A stick belonging to the missing man was found, and this led to the discovery a short distance away of the body covered in several feet of snow.
