

# Death of Popular Citizen

The death occurred at his residence, Belfield, Ennis Road, on Monday night of Mr J J Foley. He had been ailing for a long period. A popular member of a well-known Limerick family, he had carried on business as a forage contractor, and had dealt in horses particularly during the big war. He owned and raced several fine horses, and was a keen follower of the turf. Amongst his horses were Flower Vale, a winner of the Cesarewitch. The remains were removed to St Munchin's Church on Tuesday evening, and Requiem Mass was celebrated on Wednesday morning, after which the funeral, which was an immense cortège, took place to Mount St Lawrence Cemetery.
