An Infant's Death

Case Against Co. Limerick Woman

The discovery of the body of a male infant buried in a backyard had a dramatic sequel before a special court at the Garda Station, Newcastle West, on Monday, when Mrs Elizabeth Doody (40), Garryduff, Newcastle West, was charged with murdering the child on the night of the 19th February

Sergt Daly, Newcastle West, stated that the accused was taken into custody on Sanday. When charged and cautioned she said: "I have nothing to say except that I hope I will be back to my two little children

Answering Mr M Lavan (Mossre J P Lavan and Co, solr, Newcaste West), who represented the accused, witness said he first went to the accused's house on Saturday at 4 30 pm.

Mr Lavan-Did she bring the superinterdent around and show him where the child was in the backyard !- Yes, she did.

Forther questioned, witness said that accused admitted that she had put a string around the child's neck after it was born and subsequently buried it in the backyard.

Supt Heliand saked to have the accused remanded in costody to Dromcollogher

Court on Friday, 6th March. Mr Lavan asked for bail and said that substantial suieties would be forthcoming.

The Superintendent opposed the application, and the accused was remanded to 6th March.

Sitting at the Courthouse, Newcastle West, Mr R Cusseo, coroner for West Limerick, opened the inquest on the body of the child.

Medical evidence was given by Dr Nora O'Conuor, who stated that, with the assistance of Dr N O'Genter, she held a postmortem examination on the boay. Earth was adhering to parts of the body and there were several purple patches on the skin. A chord was tied tightly around the neck three times forming a deep indenture. The examination revealed that the child had lived and breathed. In her opinion death was one to strangulation caused by tying a oord tighty around the neck of the child.

The coroner then adjourned the inquest pending the hearing of the criteriosi charge

sgainst the accused woman.
