

Tipperary Road Tragedy

Inquest on Dr. P. B. Ryan

Death due to shock and coma resulting from injuries received, and which was accelerated by diabetes was the verdict returned at the inquest on Dr Ryan, 36, dispensary M.O. for Emly, Co Tipp., who died following a motor. accident at Emly on Feb. 17.

Dr Coffey, Tipperary, said he was aware Dr Ryan suffered from diabetes. He found deceased in pain, suffering from a broken leg in his car up against a roadside fence. When Dr Moran he attended Dr Ryan at his home, and brought him to a private hospital in Tipperary.

John Carron, 18, of Drumcannonogue, said he accompanied Dr Ryan to show him to a patient's house. Dr Ryan said it was hard to drive owing to the snow. Soon after the car struck a fence at Bartons cross. Dr Ryan asked him was he alright. Witness shouted for help as the doctor's leg was jammed.
