### Farmer's Death in Clare Court

At Kilrush Courthouse on Tuesday, a most respectable farmer named John Green, aged about 60 years, residing on a large farm at Kilmacduane, Cooraclare, collapsed.

Deceased, who was a very popular figure, leaves a widow and five children.
