## Twelve Months Sentence on Co. Limerick Woman

Before Mr Hanns and a jury, at the Central Criminal Court in Dublin on Thuriday, Elizabeth Doody (41), a widow, of Garryduf, Newcastle West, the Line-rick, was charged with the murder of her unnamed male infant child on the 19th February, 1936

The accused pleaded not guilty of murder

but guilty of man-laughter.
