

Sad Demise

Death of Popular Young Citizen

It is with deepest sympathy and regret we record the passing of one of Limerick's most popular citizens. Mr. Jack Toomey, eldest son of the late Denis Toomey, of the firm of Messrs. Toomey and Sons, mineral water manufacturers, Upper William Street, who died at Barrington's Hospital in the early hours of Monday morning. Mr. Toomey was only 36 years of age, and for some time past had been in failing health. Some few years ago he was a popular figure on local concert and light opera programmes. He was ever ready at the call of charity, and it was in its cause that most of his work in the musical life of the city was undertaken. Deceased was a popular member of the Shannon Rowing Club and Garryowen R.F.C. We wish to join in the general sympathy extended to his brothers, sisters and relatives.
