

Funeral of Mr J Ryan

Former Official of Limerick County Board

The funeral took place in Limerick on Sunday of Mr J Ryan, a former Secretary of the County Board G.A.A., whose death took place in London. In 1917 he, with the present County Registrar, Mr H O'B Moran, solicitor, was sentenced to six months imprisonment for having produced at Pall-mall court a secret R.I.C. circular.

Mr Ryan refused to admit that the R.I.C. to Gaelic matches, and at a subsequent trial Mr Moran, who defended him, read a secret circular to the police in which it was stated that they should pay the admission fee if demanded.
