

Ballybunion Tragedy

Man's Fatal Heart Attack While Bathing

Frank O'Donnell, aged 46, married, a shopkeeper in Newcastle West, county Limerick, died under tragic circumstances at Ballybunion on Sunday.

Deceased went for a bath about five o'clock, and after being in the water for a few minutes he got a heart attack. He was brought out of the water by a friend named Myles. A priest and Dr Hannon, M. O. R., and two other doctors, were quickly on the scene, but, despite their efforts, deceased succumbed.
