Funeral of Mr Batt. C Collins, Abbeyfeale

There was a large attendance at the interment of the late Mr Batt. C Collins, of Kingalaud, Abbeyfeale, county Limerick. Aged 74, Mr Collins had been County Councillor for the division from the establishment of the council until failing health some years ago compelled him to retire.

He was brother of Very Rev Michael Collins, C.S.S., and of Rev Mother Ewells, of the Mercy Order, Carysfort, Dublin.

A consistent Nationalist since the days of the Land and National Leagues, and a supporter of every movement for the advancement of the country's interests, his death is deeply regretted in Limerick and Kerry, and particularly by the poor.
