Charged With Causing Man's Death

At a special court at Nenagh, James J Puzan, whose address was stated to be 11 Davis street, Limerick, was charged with causing the death of Edward Barrett, labourer, aged 53, William street, Nenagh, by knocking him down with a van on Sunday evening.

He was remanded in custody until Thursday.

Sergeant Price said Puzan made a statement which was being reserved for the present.

At first he said: "I have nothing to say" and later made a statement.

Barrett, who leaves a wife and three children, was found unconscious on St Condon's Road.
