### English Pastor Dies in Co. Limerick

The death took place on Monday of the Very Rev Michael O'Hilly, Pastor, St Mary's Falmouth. The deceased clergyman was a native of Knockturna, Knocking, Co. Limerick, where he died suddenly. He was ordained about 40 years ago for the English Mission, and spent the greater part of his religious life in Falmouth, where he was universal esteem for his many priestly qualities. His death at the age of 68 leaves the Catholic Church in England immeasurably poorer. He was on a holiday at home with his sister when his death took place.
