Mr. Lemass replied as follows:-"In view of the many factors involved, which are at present indeterminate, I am not in a position to say when the Shannon Airport will be available for service. Trans-Atlantic Air Transport services dealt with in the international agreement to which the Deputy refers are a separate matter from the provision of the airport. The international agreement does not, therefore, contain any stipulation as to a time limit or other condition incidental to the consctruction of the airport, which is being undertaken and financed solely by the Saoistat Government. It will be appreciated, nevertheless, that the development of the trans-Atlantic Air Transport Services by way of the Saorstat depends upon the provision of a suitable airport in this country."
