

A Lack of Cheap Potatoes.

Questions in connection with the new alcohol factories in the Free State will be put to Ministers early in the coming session of the Dail. It appears that while two of the factories are completed very little alcohol has so far been produced, for the reason that potatoes are not available in sufficient quantities and at an economic price. When the legislation for the setting up of the factories was going through the Dail it was suggested that the necessary potatoes would be available at 35s. per ton. This has not been borne out by the fact. An increased price of 40s. per ton has been offered, but without the necessary response. This is not surprising, seeing that the ordinary market price is substantially higher. Information is also lacking as to the price at which the spirit will be available to the consumer.

Two of the new factories are in County Donegal, one in Mayo, one in Monaghan, and one in Louth.
