**CATTLE EXPORT LICENCES.**

It has come to the notice of the Department of Agriculture that there has been a scarcity of licences for the export of fat cattle, bulls and dry cows at one or two recent fairs. This scarcity is entirely due to the fact that feeders have not made application to the local Committees for the necessary number of licences. Farmers having such cattle ready for marketing are strongly advised in their own interest to make immediate application to the Secretary of the Committee of Agriculture of the County in which the cattle are located, for the number and kind of licences required. If this course is not followed it is highly probable that farmers will be unable to dispose of such cattle for export or they may be forced to accept considerably lower prices.

Shippers who purchase fat cattle or bulls and dry cows for export without licences do so at their own risk, as licences can be procured only by feeders and through Committees of Agriculture.
