Mr Tynan said he was not aware that the girl had been in the Convent.

Judge McElligott said he would risk irregularity and would have the girl re-committed to the Good Shepherd Convent. He would have to communicate with Dublin on the matter by wire, and in view of the circumstances he would remit entirely the sentence on the mother, Mary Moriarty.
