

Death of Miss M. C. Doyle

We regret to announce the death of Miss Mary Caroline Doyle, who passed away at her residence, Glen Thorn, Kinsis Road, Limerick, on Tuesday.

Mrs. Doyle was eldest daughter of the late Daniel Doyle and sister of Mr. James A. Doyle, solicitor; of the late County Court Judge Doyle, and the late Mr. D. S.
