## Compensation Awarded To Sister Of Victim

Judge Davitt, on Friday, in the Circuit Court, Dublin, awarded £300 compensation to Florence Phillips, 5, St. Stephen's Street, Dorset street, Dublin, who sought compensation under the Workmen's Compensation Act from Messrs O'Coole and Baileys, South William Street, Dublin, in view of the death of her brother, Paul Phillips, which occurred while he was employed in a shop fitted by the respondent company.

It appeared that the deceased man was engaged in the erection of a shop in Limerick in September last when the building collapsed and he fell into the basement. The facts of the case were not contested.
