Compensation Awarded To Sister Of Victim

Judge Davitt, on Friday, in the Circuit Court, Dublin, awarded £300 compensation to Florence Phillips, St. Joseph's Place, Dorset street, Dublin, who sought compensation under the Workmen's Compensation Act from Messrs O'Connell and Bailey, South William street, Dublin, arising out of the death of her brother, Pat Phillips, which occurred while he was employed as a shop fitter by the respondent company.

It appeared that the deceased was engaged in the erection of a shop in Limerick in September last when the building collapsed and he fell into the basement. The facts of the case were not contested.
