

Limerick 1916 Man

Passes Away in Dublin

The death has taken place at his residence, St. Moibhí Road, Glasnevin, Dublin, of Mr. Thomas J. O'Connor, a native of Limerick. Deceased had conducted a business in Dublin, retiring some years ago. He was one of the early members of Sinn Féin. He took part in the 1916 Rising in the Church street area, and was attached to "F" Company, 1st Batt., Dublin Brigade, I.R.A. While in Limerick he was an active member of St. Michael's Temperance Society, and was a Silver Jubilee of the Arch Confraternity of the Holy Family attached to the Redemptorist Church. He was the father of Mr P O'Connor, S.A.A.A.; Mr John B O'Connor, esq., Dublin, and Mr D O'Connor, New York.

He was brother of our well-known citizen, Mr R P O'Connor, ex B.U.
