

Death of Miss M. O'Sullivan

It is with most sincere regret that we record the death of Miss Margaret O'Sullivan, of 1 Mount Pleasant Avenue, which sad event took place on Sunday last after a brief illness. Deceased was the last surviving sister of the late Mr Christopher O'Sullivan, proprietor of the LIMERICK Echo. For a long number of years, and up to the time of her passing, she was Secretary of the B.V.M.
