

Commercial Traveller's Death

Collision Near Boher.

John Rice, 32, unmarried, a native of Fethard on Sea, Wexford, died in the Co. Infirmary, Wexford, at 11.45 p.m. on Friday night, following injuries when his car collided with a lorry at Boher earlier in the evening.

Deceased was a representative of Messrs Pierce, Wexford, and was going in the Limerick direction when the impact took place. Deceased received severe head injuries.

Mr J S McNeice, solicitor, Deputy Coroner, held an inquest at the County Infirmary on Saturday, when medical evidence and evidence of identification was given.

The inquest was then adjourned pending proceedings against the driver of the lorry, which is stated to belong to a Clonmel firm.

The late Mr Rice was for a number of years employed at Messrs F Spaight & Sons Ltd, Limerick, and his remains, which were removed on Saturday evening, were accompanied by a large number of friends from Limerick, where deceased was a very popular figure.
