

# Clare P.P.'s Death

## Passing Of Rev D McMamara, Nenagh

The death took place on Sunday in a private nursing home, Dublin, of Rev D McNamara, P.P. Portroe, Nenagh.

The deceased administered as curate in Crusheen, Kiltisheen, Ballynacally and Killaloe. About four years ago he was appointed P.P. of Portroe, where he was beloved by his parishioners, who deeply mourn his passing. On his appointment to Portroe he immediately set to work to improve the church and grounds surrounding it, and was responsible for the erection of the luminous cross on Loughtea Hill, which can be viewed from seven counties, and erected to commemorate the Holy Year.

The deceased was son of the late Mr D McNamara, Lissofie, Tulla, and brother of Rev Matthew McNamara, O.C. Castleconnell, and an uncle of Dr Bagler, Ennis, of Rev Fr Bagler, Goulburr, Australia, who recently paid him a visit, and of Sister Mary Oliver, of the Convent of Mercy, Nenagh. After his ordination the deceased ministered in Skel for several years in the diocese of Down and Connor.
