
Death of Captain T. Considine

The death occurred at his residence, Derk Co Limerick, of Captain Talbot J Considine after a long illness. He served in the Great War with the Dublin Fusiliers and was twice wounded. Captain Considine's four brothers also served in the war.

His eldest brother, Captain Heffernan Considine, M.C., Royal Irish Regiment, and another brother, Lieut. Christopher Considine, Royal Dublin Fusiliers, were killed in France. Captain Talbot Considine was second son of the late Sir Heffernan Considine, C.B., M.V.O., D.L., Deputy Inspector-General of the R.I.C. The funeral took place at Ballinaclough Cemetery, close to the Derk demesne.
