Death of Captain T. Considine

Son of Late Deputy-Inspector-General, R.I.C.

The death occurred at his residence, Derk Co Limerick, of Captain Talbot J Considing after a long illores. He served in the Great War with the Dublio Positiers and was twice wounded. Captain Considing's four brothers also served in the war His eldest brother, Captain Heffernan Considing, Mc. Royal Irish Regiment, and another brother, Lieut, Chrisopher Considine, Royal Dublio Fusiliers, were killed in France. Captain Talbot Considing was second son of the late Sir Heffernan Considine, CB KVO DL. Deputy Inspector-General of the R I C. The funeral took place at Ballinaclough Cemetary, elese to the Derk demesne.
