

# Death of Rev Father Brown, C.S.S.R.

## Former Director of Arch- Confraternity

With most sincere regret we have to announce the death of Rev Father Terence Brown, C.S.S.R., which took place at Esker, Athlery, Co. Galway, on Sunday.

The late Father Brown, who was in his 58th year, was a native of Doodale, and was a student of the seminary at Mt. St. Alphonse, before his ordination. He then went to the Philippines and from thence to Australia.

On his return to Ireland he conducted a number of important missions before his appointment as Director of the Arch-Confraternity of the Holy Family in succession to Rev J J Murray, C.S.S.R. Father Brown was forced to relinquish the onerous position after a few months owing to health reasons.

Addressing the members of Tuesday's division of the Arch-Confraternity in the Redemptorist Church on Sunday night, Rev Father Fox, C.S.S.R. Spiritual Director, alluded to the death of Father Brown and said that the news would fill them all with deep sorrow and regret. Father Brown, he said, had celebrated Mass that morning. A little later he complained and in the space of half an hour death had supervened.

Father Fox asked the members of the Confraternity to offer their Rosary for the happy repose of the soul of the deceased.

The interment took place today at Esker after Office and Solemn Requiem Mass at 11 o'clock.
