A Distinguished Churchman

We regret to autounce the death of Rt. Rev Mussignor Michael O'Donnell, P P.V S. Deap of Limarick Diocese, which took piace at the Parochial House, Rathheale, on Monday night.

Moos, O'Donnell, who was born at Croom to 1954, was educated at Carlow and the Isiah College in Rome.
